During BioForum 2010 Hasco-lek will award winners of the contest for the best PhD and MSc thesis

Master's theses covered wide spectrum of topics including works on tissue cultures in transplantation, methods of encapsulating drugs, new drugs development, extracts and ecological fuel cells.
